Gourmet quality blackberry growing on a truly thorn free, vigorous plant. Short, semi-erect canes.

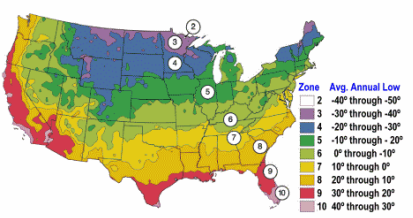
Highly productive - it has become the #1 commercial producer in the U.K.

Selected from a family of seedlings resulting from a cross made in 1978 at the Scottish Crop Research Institute (SCRI), Dundee, UK, between two unnamed blackberry selections of complex parentage. Plant Patent 6782.

Self Fertile.

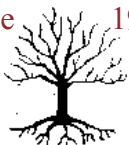
Long season ripening: Late June to end July. August til frost further north.
