

# Chickasaw Blackberry

*Rubus sp.*

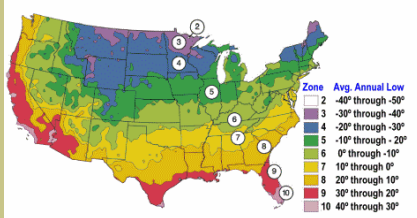
This high yielding variety produces large high quality fruit on vigorous erect canes. The fruit is long, cylindrical, and slightly flattened in shape and very attractive with a glossy, black finish.

Resistant to anthracnose.

Developed by the University of Arkansas.

Ripens: Beginning approximately June 10 at Clarksville, Arkansas, and fruiting extends for five to six weeks.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 5.
