

Sunshine Blue Blueberry

Vaccinium hybrid

For gardens from San Diego to Seattle, Sunshine Blue has it all.

This semi-dwarf evergreen blueberry features a highly branched compact habit. The showy hot pink flowers fade to white in spring, yielding large crops of dime sized, delicious blueberries with a unique, tangy flavor for up to 9 weeks in the summer.

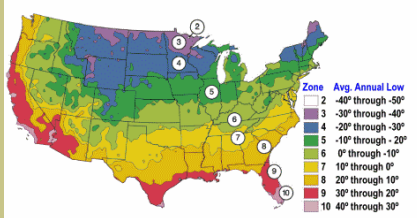
Sunshine Blue tolerates higher pH soils better than other blueberries. The low chilling requirement makes it suitable for Southern California but it is surprisingly cold hardy and a wonderful addition to Northwest gardens.

Self Fertile.

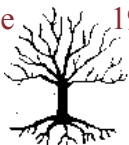
Requires 150 hours chilling below 45° F.
