

# Nectarberries

*Rubus ursinus*

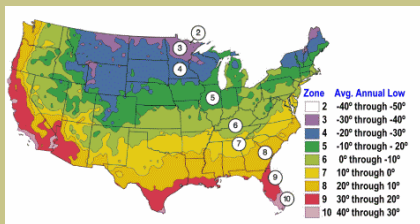
Scientifically the same berry and plant as Regular Boysenberry.

Large (1 1/2" long by 1" thick), non-shiny reddish-black colored berry. Soft, very juicy, sweet-tart tasting berry. Delightful aroma. Dark green foliage, dusty bloom with medium to large thorns. Good for canning, freezing and eating fresh.

Does well in mild winter areas.

Ripens: May to June

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 6. Needs winter protection below 0 degrees F.
