Rubus occidentalis 'Munger'

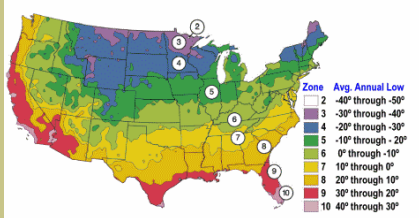
Large, plump yet firm, shiny black berries that are not seedy. Delicious, sweet flavor that is excellent for jam, jellies and preserves. Only fair for freezing.

Developed in Ohio. Stout canes appear to be more resistant to fungal diseases. Leading variety in Pacific Northwest, commercially & home garden.

Very hardy.

Mature height is 6-9 feet, spread of 4-8 feet.

Cold hardy to USDA Zone 4.
