

Tayberry

Rubus sp.

Large, long conical shape berry. Bright, deep purplish-red color, slightly aromatic, excellent flavor.

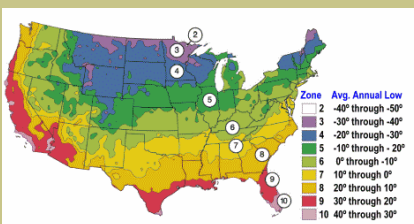
Growth habit similar to a blackberry. Fruit is well displayed and easy to pick on long canes. A cross between Aurora Blackberry and a Raspberry. Developed by the Scottish Crop Research Institute.

Produces higher yields and is less acidic than Loganberry. Good disease resistance.

Fresh eating or used for making jams, pies or wine.

Ripens: Late June through Early August.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 7 maybe 6b.
