

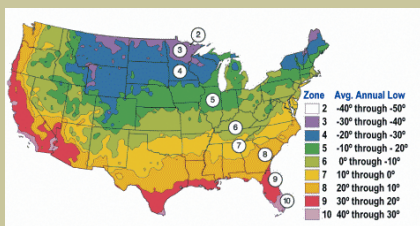
Thornless Youngberries

Medium, reddish-black berry. A less vigorous grower with lower fruit yields compared to Regular Boysenberry. Good for mild winter areas. Popular with home owners because it is thornless.
