

Hall's Hardy Almond

Prunus dulcis

A recommended almond for colder winter areas.

Medium size, hard shell. Delicious, sweet kernels. Hardy and heavy bearer.

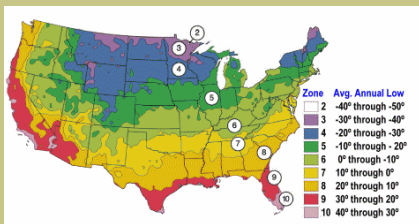
Beautiful, profuse pink blooms is **sometimes sold just for its beauty**. Late bloomer makes it a suitable candidate for cold areas.

Semi self-fertile, but does better with pollinizer. Best pollinizer is Texas (Mission) Almond.

Requires 800 hours chilling below 45° F.

Mature height is 15-20 feet with a spread of 15-20 feet.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 6
