

# Anders™ Apple

*Malus sp.*

Medium to large. Greenish-yellow base overlaid with generous red strippling. Crisp, white flesh is sweet with some tang, flavorful. Excellent for eating, drying, baking, and cooking. Eaten on green side, reminds you of Granny Smith. Eaten more ripe, reminds you of a Fuji Apple.

Suitable for mild climates, estimated to need less than 500 hours chilling below 45°F.

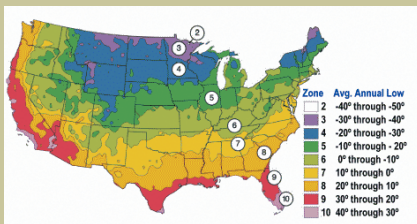
Discovered as a seedling in Somis, California. Appears to be codling moth resistant

Ripens: Extended season from August to November.

Cold Hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 7.
