

Anna Apple

Malus sp.

A remarkable low chilling selection originally from Israel especially suited for Southern California and low desert areas.

Large apple. Light greenish-yellow skin with slight red blush. Sweet, slightly tart, crisp, creamy white flesh. Good choice for salads, pies, apple sauce and eating fresh from the tree. Stores well.

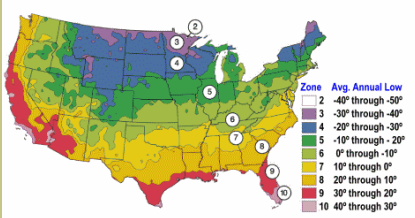
Bears fruit at an early age.

Self fertile but recommend a pollinizer such as Dorsett Golden for better production.

Ripens: Late June

Requires 200-300 hours chilling below 45° F.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 5 and probably 4.



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
