Prunus armeniaca sp.

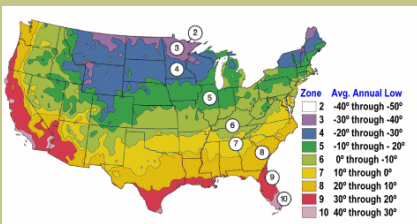
Large, elongated fruit. Orange skin, orange flesh with very good flavor.

Developed at Washington State Univ. Sets and sizes fruit in cool, frosty, spring weather where other varieties fail.

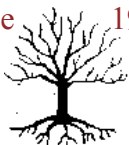
Requires 700 hours chilling below 45°F.

Ripens: August in cooler climates, Early July in Central California

Cold Hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 6 - maybe lower.
