

Katy Apricot

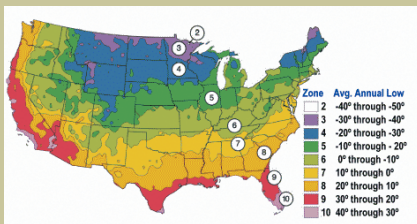
Prunus armeniaca sp.

A great apricot for mild winter areas. Fruit is large and very flavorful. Good for fresh eating, drying, or canning. Free-stone. Self-fertile.

Requires 300-400 hours of chill below 45 °F.

Ripens in June, 3-4 weeks before the Royal.

Cold Hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 7.



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
