Prunus cerasus sp.

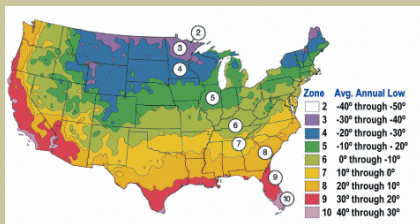
Excellent for canning and pies.

A sour cherry. Medium. Bright red skin deepening to mahogany. Yellow, juicy, tender flesh. Attractive small tree, naturally small growing only to 8-10 feet. Productive, resistant to leaf spot and brown rot. Very cold hardy. Self-fertile.

Requires 1000 hours chilling below 45°F.

Ripens: Mid to Late Season

Cold Hardy to
U.S.D.A. Zone 4.
