Ficus carica

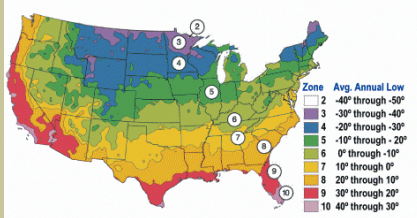
Large. Light green skin. Whitish-strawberry flesh. Flavor sweet and mild. Good for table use and drying. Resistant to spoilage. Good white fig for hot areas and will take desert winter chill.

This semi-tropical tree requires negligible chilling hours.

Ripens: Throughout the summer and into the fall.

Mature height is 20 feet with a spread of 20-25 feet.

Cold Hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 8.
