

Southern Flame "Patio" Peach

Prunus persica sp.

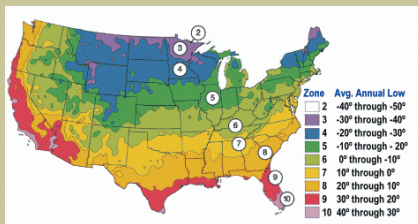
Large. Yellow skin overspread with red. Firm, crisp, melting, yellow flesh. Good eating quality and aroma. Compares favorably with commercial peaches. Freestone. Good for mild winter areas.

Requires 400 hours of chilling below 45°F.

Ripens in Early to Mid July.

Mature height is 5 feet with a spread of 5-6 feet.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 7.
