

Beurre d'Anjou Pear

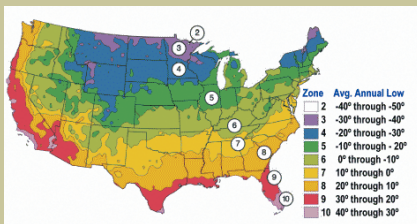
Pyrus communis sp.

Buttery texture does justice to its French name. Medium to large, green skin turning to yellow when ripe. Crimson blush skin. Short neck. Good eating.

Requires 700 hours of chill below 45 °F.

Ripens: September.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 5.



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
