Large. Yellow skin. Firm, juicy white flesh. Resembles Bartlett in looks and flavor. Consistent bearer. Prolonged, progressive blooming period ideal for late frost areas. Very Fireblight resistant and cold hardy.

Self Fertile.

Ripens: September

Requires 900 hours chilling below 45° F

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 5.
