

Sugar Pear

Pyrus communis

Medium to small, round to bell shaped. Skin smooth, yellow-brown suffused with russet red. Creamy white, good textured flesh, very sweet flavor. Good for preserving.

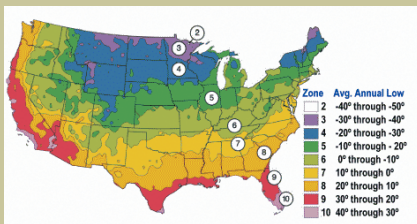
Tree's growth is narrower than most pears allowing it to fit in smaller yards.

Good for mild winter areas as well as cold areas. Will fruit heavier with more chilling. Self-fertile in arid West.

Requires 300 hours of chill below 45°F.

Ripens in mid to late August.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 7.
