

Lakota Pecan

Carya illinoensis sp.

Exceptional quality with bright kernels. Medium sized nut.

A key attraction is it is suited for northern pecan regions up to Illinois.

Very precocious and productive. Late pollen shed.

Very resistant to scab disease, with medium susceptibility to yellow and black aphids.

Very early harvest - two weeks after Pawnee.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 6, maybe 5b.
