

Chocolate Persimmon

Diospyros kaki sp.

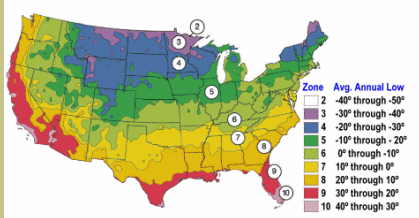
Highly productive tree producing medium to small, elongated fruit. Very tasty, sweet, brown flesh. Non-astringent when ripe.

Foliage is attractive lime green in early spring, dark green in summer with orange fall color.

Ripens: Late October into Early November

Medium tree height with an approximate mature height of 20-25 feet and a spread of 10-15 feet.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 7.
