Popular fresh eating
Japanese Persimmon.

Large, round, flattened.
(more “square” and
flatter than Jiro).

Reddish-orange skin.
Good eating. Smooth
texture. Non-astringent.

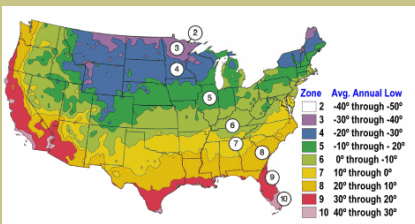
Ripens in November

Mature height is 20-30
feet with a spread of 10-
15 feet.

Requires less than 200
hours chilling below
45° F.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A.
Zone 7.

Sunset Zones 5-9, 11,
14-23, 26-33



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
