

# Tamopan Persimmon

*Diospyros kaki*

Fruit is extra large. Round shaped with an acorn-like cap. Golden red skin. Tender, juicy, sweet flesh.

Astringent - eat fresh only when very soft. Excellent for cooking and baking when firm to soft.

Showy red-orange fall color. Self Fertile

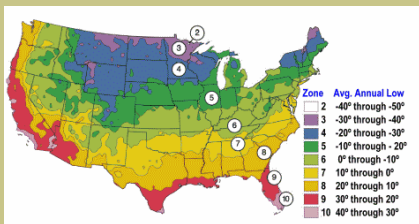
Ripens: November

Mature height is 20-30 feet with a spread of 18-25 feet.

Requires less then 200 hours chilling below 45° F.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 7.

Sunset Zones: 6-9, 14-16, 18-24, 26-33
