A unique and unforgettable eating delight.

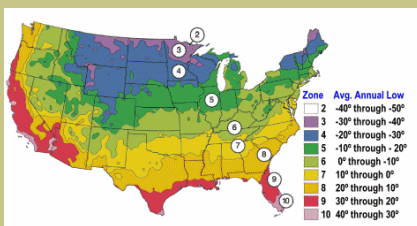

Self Fertile.

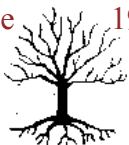
Freestone - pit is small.
