

Granada Pomegranate

Punica granatum sp.

Bud mutation of Wonderful Pomegranate discovered in Lindsay, California

Resembles Wonderful with deeper red blossoms, large, regular bearing fruit and ripens one month earlier. Fruit is a darker color and less tart. Bush/tree is identical in size and shape as Wonderful.

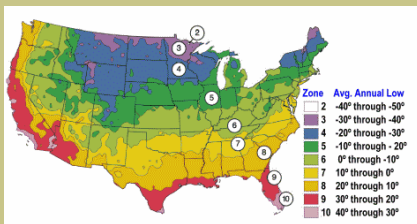
Recommended for coastal climates over Wonderful.

Ripens in August.

Requires 150-200 chilling hours below 45° F.

Mature height is 20 feet with a spread of 15-20 feet.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 9.
