

Wonderful Pomegranate

Punica granatum sp.

The most well known of the pomegranates. The one against which all others are measured.

Extra large. Blushed red skin. Flesh is rich, red color, juicy with sharp flavor.

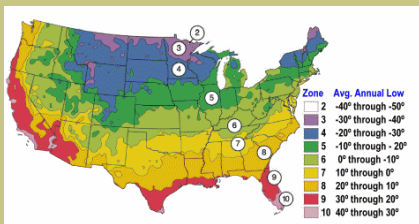
Grows well in alkaline soils that would kill most plants.

Ripens in September.

Requires 150-200 chilling hours below 45° F.

Mature height is 18-20 feet with a spread of 15-20 feet.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 9.
