

# Cooke's Jumbo Quince

*Cydonia oblonga* sp.

Extremely large - about twice the size of other varieties.

Pear shaped. Yellowish-green skin. White flesh.

Good for cooking, pie fillings, candies and jelly. Self fertile.

Ripens: September to October.

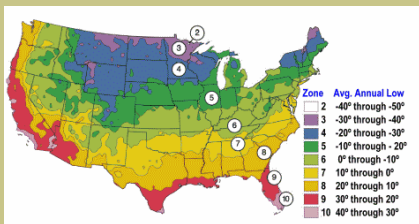
Mature height is 12-15 feet.

Requires around 100 hours of chilling below 45° F.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 5.

Found by Herb Kaprielian, Dinuba, CA.
