*Cydonia oblonga* sp.

Large, elongated.  
Lemon yellow skin.  
Flesh is tender, highly  
perfumed, with excellent  
flavor.

Good for cooking, pie  
fillings, candies and jelly.

An old Turkish variety,  
often used in colder  
climates.

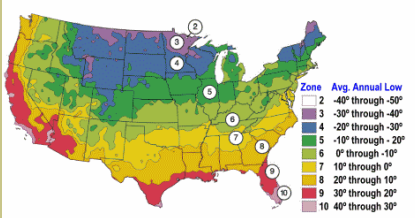
Self fertile.

Ripens: September.

Mature height is 12-15  
feet.

Requires around 100  
hours of chilling below  
45° F.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A.  
Zone 5 (maybe 4).
