Champagne Grape is also known as Black Corinth Grape or Zante Currant.

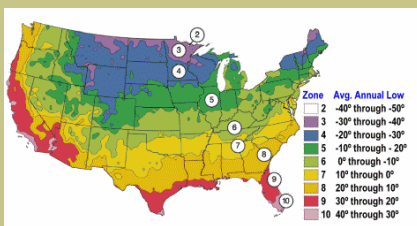
Dark red to black grape, firm skinned and crunchy with a sweet flavor. Flesh is juicy and a neutral to spicy flavor. Seedless.

Used extensively in baking or edible garnishment.

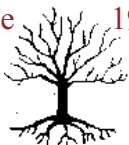
Cane pruned.
