

Merlot Wine Grape

Vitis vinifera

Yields wines of fine bouquet that are softer, more supple in texture and ages more rapidly than those of Cabernet Sauvignon.

Medium sized, round, bluish-black fruit. Medium to large clusters, long conical, loose to compact. Spur or cane pruning.

Better in cooler areas.

Self Fertile

Ripens: Late September to Early October.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 7.

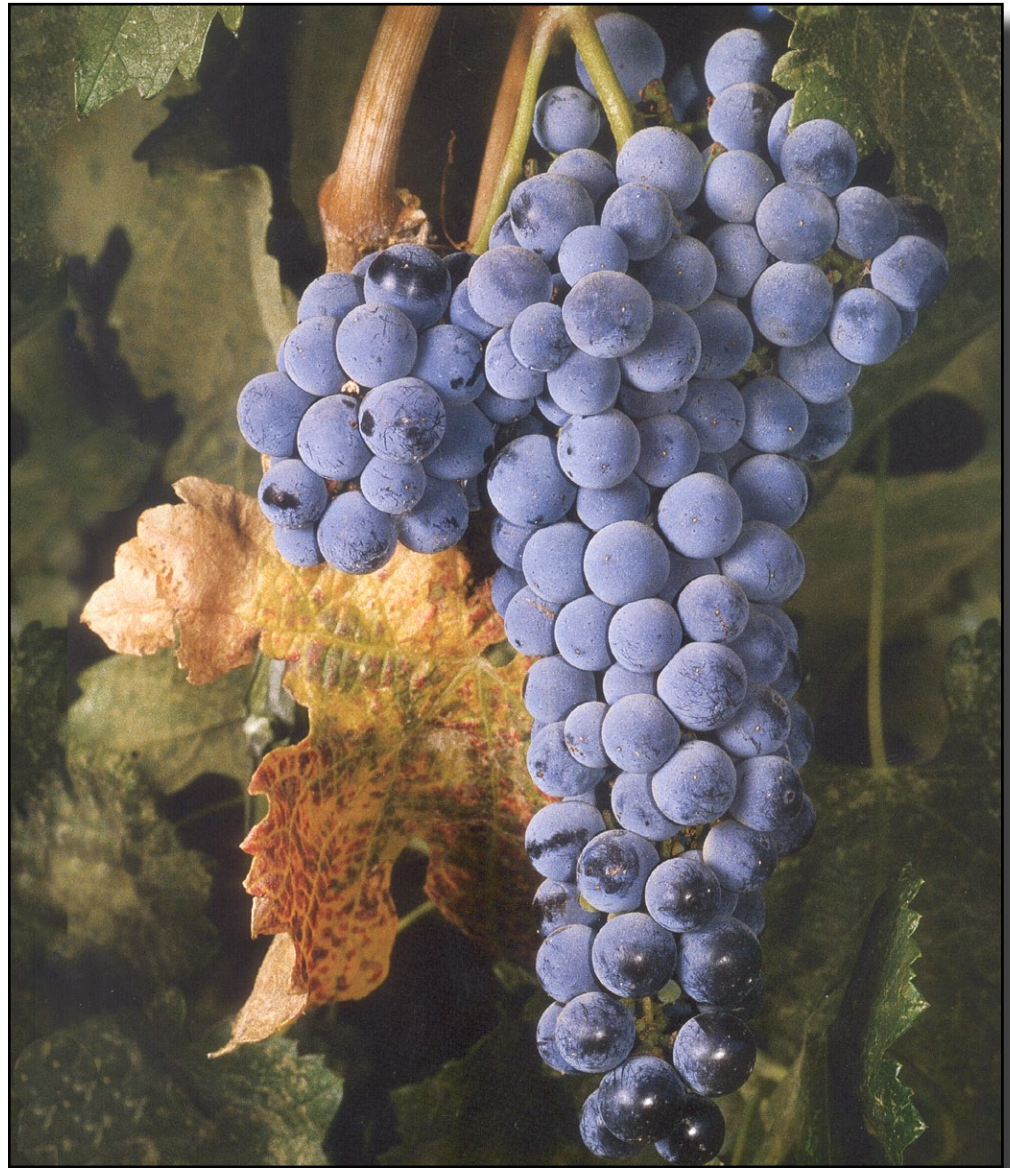
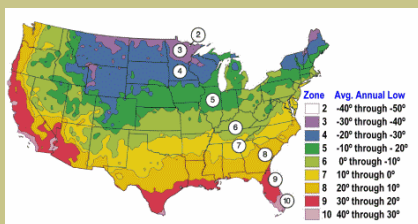
