

Golden Rain Tree

Koelreuteria paniculata

The emerging leaves are pink-red then mid-green then turning butter yellow in the autumn. Small yellow flowers form large pyramidal panicles mid - late summer followed by pink or red-flushed fruit capsules that resemble paper lanterns. An open-branched deciduous tree, may need pruning to help keep shape.

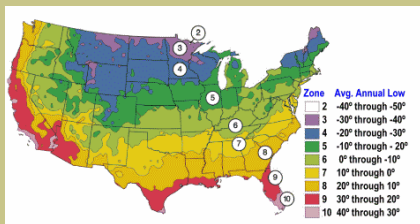
Takes the cold, heat, drought and wind well.

In some areas this tree has an invasive tendency.

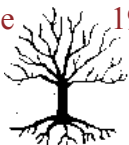
Mature height is 30-40 feet with a spread of 30-40 feet.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 5b.
