

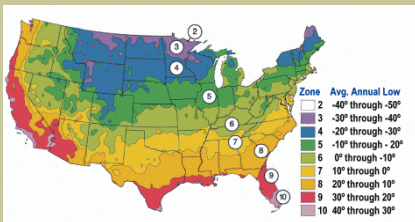
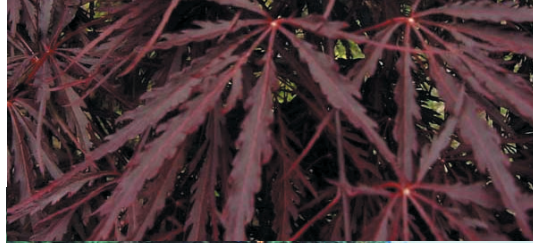
# Tamukeyama Japanese Maple

*Acer palmatum dissectum 'Tamukeyama'*

New growth on this laceleaf maple is crimson red turning to dark purple as the leaves age. Fall color is bright scarlet. This old selection, first introduced in 1710 in Japan, is rapidly growing in popularity in the Sunbelt states as a superior clone for hotter climates.

Grows to a height 6-8 feet and spread of 8-12 feet.
