

# Moniqui Apricot

*Prunus armeniaca sp.*

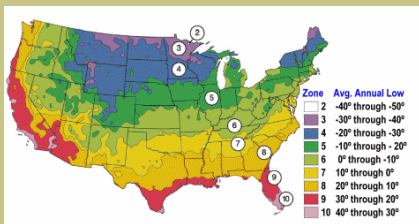
A very delicious, sweet tasting, white fleshed apricot.

Large to very large. Firm, thick skin is creamy white with coral pink blush and golden highlights around the stem. Tender, white, juicy flesh with melting texture and very sweet flavor. Very good for drying.

Requires approximately 700 hours chilling below 45° F.

Ripens: Early July, one week after Blenheim.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 7.



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
