

Wenatchee Moorpark Apricot

Prunus armeniaca sp.

Large, oval fruit. The yellow flesh has a good flavor. Excellent for fresh eating, drying, and canning. Bears heavy, self-fertile. Good for climates where spring rains and frost limit apricot production. A favorite in Oregon and Washington.

Self Fertile. Freestone

Ripens: Late June into Early July - later in cooler climates.

Requires 700 hours chilling below 45° F

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 6.
