

Brown Turkey (California) Fig

Ficus carica

Medium to large, bell shaped. Purplish-brown skin with light strawberry flesh. Sweet, best eaten fresh. Large tree. Ranges from coast to inland heat.

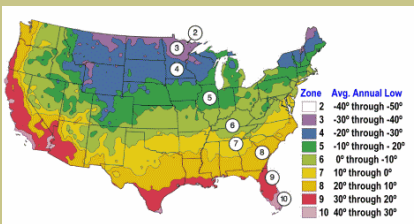
This semi-tropical tree requires negligible chilling hours (< 100 hrs.)

Ripens: Light breba crop, heavier summer-fall crop from August to nearly frost.

Mature height is 20 ft. and a spread of 20-25 ft.

Cold Hardy to U.S.D.A.
Zone 7.

To avoid confusion with other figs called Brown Turkey, this variety is the original highly prized selection grown in California since the Missions. It is not the same as Texas Everbearing, Italian Everbearing or Celeste.
