

Asparagus

Asparagus officinalis

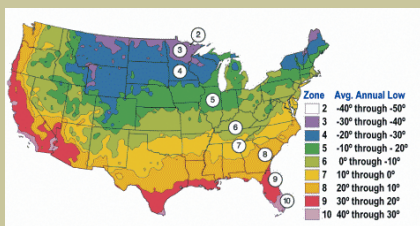
Very popular vegetable. The plant has tall, feathery, graceful stems. Plants may take up to 2-3 years to come into full production but can bear for 10-15 years.

Both U.C. 72 and U.C. 157 are disease resistant.

Harvest March to June.

Mature height is 4-5 feet with a 1-3 foot spread.

Grow in U.S.D.A. Zones 4-10.
