Punica granatum

Famous for its extra large fruit. Pale pink skin. Dark pink arils offering a purple juice with sweet-tart flavor.

Thrives in summer heat as well as coastal climates.

Self fertile.

Ripens: September into October

Requires less than 200 Chilling Hours below 45° F.

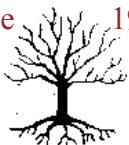
Mature height is 15-18 feet with a spread of 15-20 feet.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 9 and probably 8b.
