Punica granatum

Large. Pink-orange skin with red blush. Large orange-red flowers which continue to bloom into harvest season.

Self Fertile.

Ripens: mid to late October.

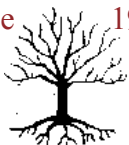
Requires less than 200 hours chilling below 45° F

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 6, maybe 5. From a plant in north Texas which has survived over 25 years with temperatures reaching -18 degrees F.
