

Texas (Mission) Almond

Prunus dulcis

Medium size, hard shell. Kernel is white, short, plump and sweet. Relatively hardy and historically heavy bearer.

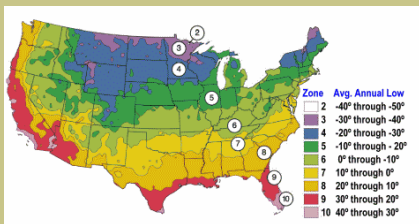
Beautiful, profuse white blooms with a pink center.

Semi self-fertile, but does better with pollinizer. Best pollinizers: Hall's Hardy or Nonpareil.

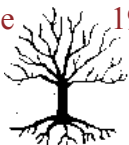
Requires 500 hours chilling below 45° F.

Mature height is 15-20 feet with a spread of 15-20 feet.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 7
