Planting Asparagus



- 1. Dig a trench 10 inches deep.
- 2. Mix 1 part soil amendment to 3 parts soil.
- 3. Plant the crown 6 inches below the surface.




4. As the plants start growing, add mixed soil little by little until even with soil surface.

Planting Strawberries



- 1. Trim extra long roots.
- 2. Mix one part soil amendment to 3 parts soil.
- 3. Set plants so crowns are even with soil.
- 4. Water in well.

Planting Artichokes



- 1. Dig a generous hole.
- 2. Mix 1 part soil amendement with 4 parts soil, add sand if needed.
- 3. Plant with buds at surface.
- 4. When growth starts, add mulch.

Planting Cane Berries



- 1. Dig planting hole.
- 2. Mix 1 part soil amendment with 3 parts soil. Add slow release fertilizer.
- 3. Set plants deep so canes just show.
- 4. Firm soil and water.

Planting Rhubarb



- 1. Dig a wide trench or hole.
- 2. Mix 1 part soil amendment with 3 parts soil.
- 3. Set root division high so buds are at surface and are not standing in water.
