

Jerusalem Artichokes

Helianthus tuberosus

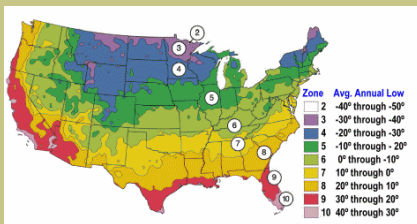
Perennial. Produces edible tubers which are good fresh, in salads, boiled or in soups.

Flowers resemble small sunflower or large daisy. Plants can be used in some landscape situations making a high hedge in one growing season.

Ripens in late fall.

Mature height is 8-10 feet with a 3-6 foot spread.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 3.
