An excellent 2003 release from University of Arkansas. Large berries with very good flavor and quality.

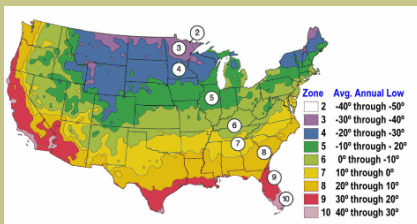
Thornless.

Consistent, high yielding production on very erect canes. Comparable to or exceeding yields of Apache and Navaho.

Ripens mid-season, around June 12 in Arkansas with fruiting continuing for about five weeks.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 7 (some say 6).
