Rubus sp.

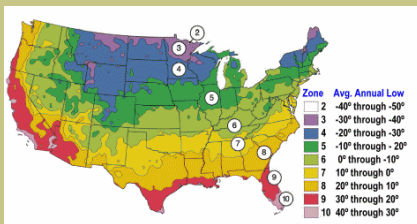
Medium to large.

Early July to Early
August
