Ribes nigrum 'Consort'

Medium clusters of somewhat soft black berries. Very prominent, sweet and unique flavor.

Good for jams, juice, sauces and wine. Excellent when dried.

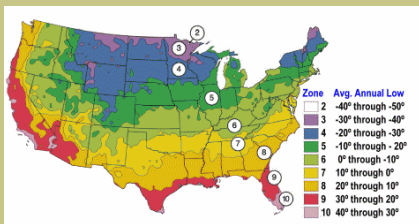
Very high source of Vitamin C.

Excellent bird forage or windbreak plants. Resistant to the White Pine blister rust fungus.

3-4 ft. high and wide.

Developed in Ottawa, Ontario and introduced in 1950.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 4 (some say 3).
