Red Lake Currants

Ribes sativum 'Red Lake'

Excellent for jellies, preserves and muffins.

Produces large, dark red berries on medium to long fruit clusters. Ripens early, in July.

Prefers cooler summer climates.

Vigorous, upright grower. Often used as fruiting hedges.

Developed in 1933 by the University of Minnesota.

Mature height is 3-5 feet with a spread of 3-5 feet.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 3.
