

Wilder Currants

Ribes sativum

Large clusters of pale red, medium sized berries.
Improved strain.

Very attractive long lived plant with dense foliage and yellowish flowers in drooping clusters.

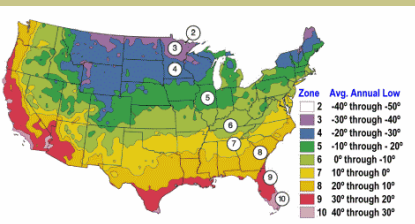
Very hardy and productive, mildew resistant. Prefers rather cool, humid, shady areas. Not suitable for hot climates.

Excellent for jellies & jams. Somewhat tart for fresh eating.

Plants grow to 3-5 feet high and 2-4 feet wide.

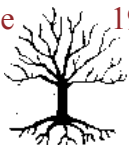
Ripens: Early to Late July.
