

Cumberland Black Cap Raspberry

Rubus occidentalis 'Cumberland'

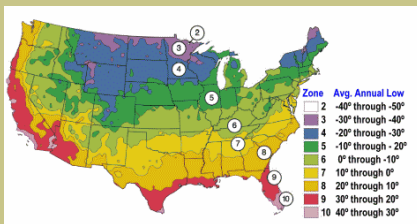
Large, glossy, blue-black, firm berry. Good for fresh eating or for freezing, jams, jellies, syrup, preserves and pies.

Native to eastern North America and is the leading commercial variety in the Northern and Central regions (like Illinois).

Ripens: Mid-season

Mature height is 6-9 feet, spread of 4-8 feet.

Good in cold climates. Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 5.
