

Newburgh Red Raspberry

Rubus idaeus var. strigosus

Very large, firm, very sweet, bright, light red berries. Mild flavor with good quality.

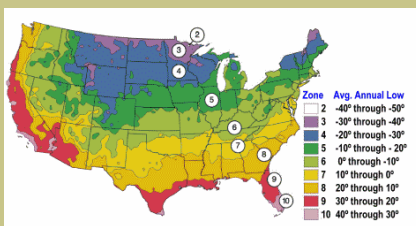
A very good variety for jelly and freezing. More suited for home use and u-pick orchards.

Heavy annual producer that is resistant to Root Rot and Mosaic Virus. Newburgh is widely adaptable and takes heavy wet soil.

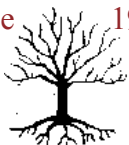
Ripens: July.

Mature height is 3-8 feet with a spread of 4-8 feet.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 3 (some say 2).
