

# Thornless Youngberries

*Rubus ursinus*

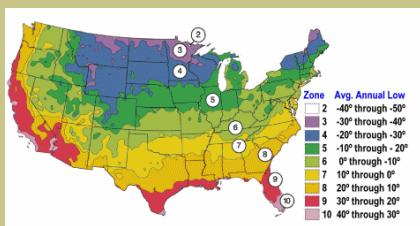
Large (1½" long, 1" thick), dark red berry. Similar to Boysenberry, but is thornless, less vigorous and does not bear fruit as heavily.

Good for mild winter areas. Excellent for the home garden. Popular with home owners because it is thornless.

Good for canning and freezing.

Ripens: May to June.

Good for mild winter areas. Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 7.
