


Yoshino Flowering Cherry

Prunus × yedoensis

Made famous by the Washington D.C. Tidal Basin. Yoshino Flowering Cherry is a rapidly growing tree that is extraordinarily beautiful in the spring when it is covered with single, white, shell-pink cotton candy like blossoms. Foliage is a glossy dark green and fall color lasts into November. Makes an excellent street tree.

Grows to a height of 30 feet and spread of 30 feet.
