

# Burgundy Apple

*Malus sp.*

An excellent dessert quality apple. Medium-large. Glossy, dark red color similar to color of a Bing Cherry.

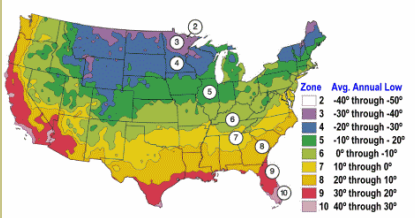
Pollinizer highly recommended. Good pollinizers include Gala, Red Delicious or McIntosh.

Introduced by Cornell University in Geneva, NY.

Ripens: Early August along coastal California and Mid September in New York.

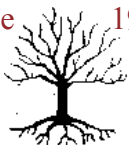
Requires 500-600 Chilling Hours below 45° F.

Cold hardy to U.S.D.A. Zone 5, maybe 4.
